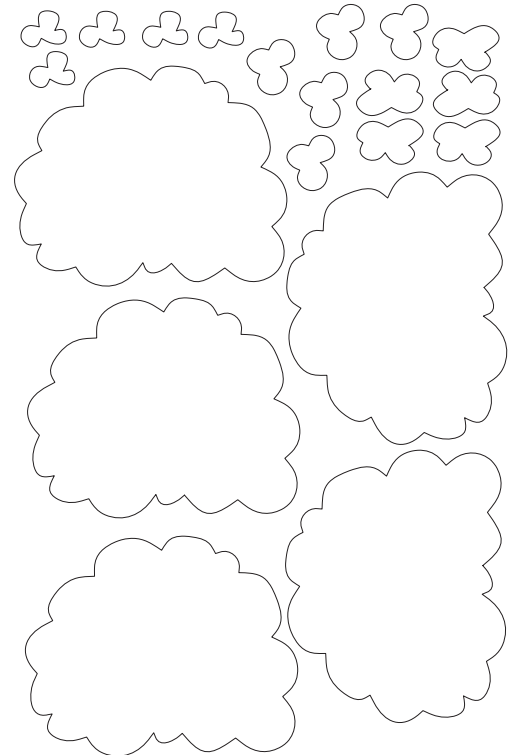
Faith as a Mustard Seed Magnet

Supplies:

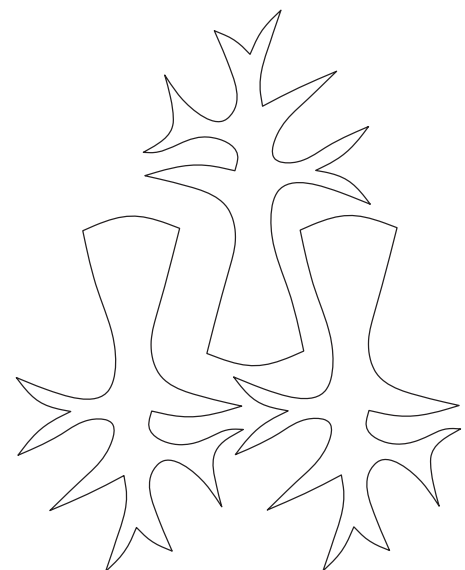
- Brown tree trunk from paper or foamy (1 per child)
- Paper with Bible reference, Matthew 17:20 (1 per child)
- Green tree shape, cut from paper, felt, or foamy (1 per child)
- Green leaves from the same material as the tree (3 per child)
- Tiny seed (1 per child)
- Glue
- Little strip of magnet or magnetic tape

Instructions:

1. Glue the Bible reference to the lower corner of the green tree.
2. Next, glue the brown trunk onto the green tree as shown in the picture.
3. Glue the green leaves wherever desired on the tree.
4. Next, glue the little seed near the roots of the tree.
5. Finally, glue the magnet to the back of the tree. Remind the students to put their names on their crafts.

Lost Sheep

Supplies:

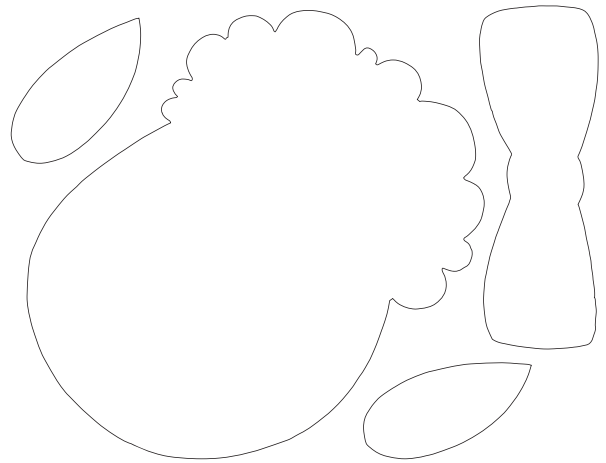
- White paper sheep head, ears, and bow tie pattern (1 for each student)
- Crayons
- Black eyes, mouth, and nose from paper, felt, or foamy
- Small amount of popcorn (aprox 25 pieces per student)
- Glue

Instructions:

1. Write the Bible verse on the bow tie. (Matthew 18:14)
Lightly color the bowtie.
2. Next, color the head and ears of the sheep. Remind the students to put their names on their crafts.
3. Glue the bowtie, ears, eyes, nose, and mouth onto the sheep.
4. Spread a thin layer of glue where the sheep fur is desired and press some popcorn into the glue.

Pearl of Great Price

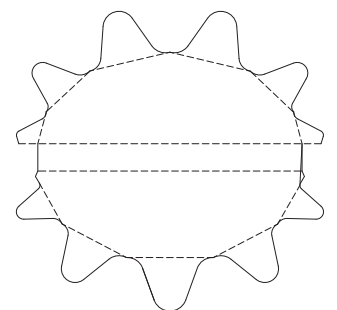
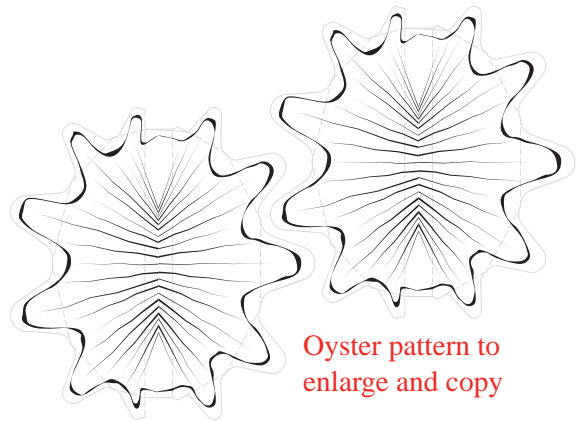


Supplies:

- Oyster body from paper or a disposable plate (1 per student)
- Enlarge and copy the pattern to the right.
- Small white cotton ball or strofoam ball (1 per student)
 - Crayons, colored pencils, or water color paint
 - Paper with the Bible verse, or paper on which to write the verse
 - Glue

Instructions:

1. Color both sides of the oyster while it's flat. Remind the students to put their names on their crafts.
2. After coloring, fold on the dotted lines of the pattern of the oyster into a closed book shape, curling down the front edges as shown.
3. Insert the Styrofoam or cotton ball as a pearl inside the oyster and, if desired, glue it into place.
4. Write the Bible verse on a slip of paper (or type and print them) and glue it inside the pearl.
